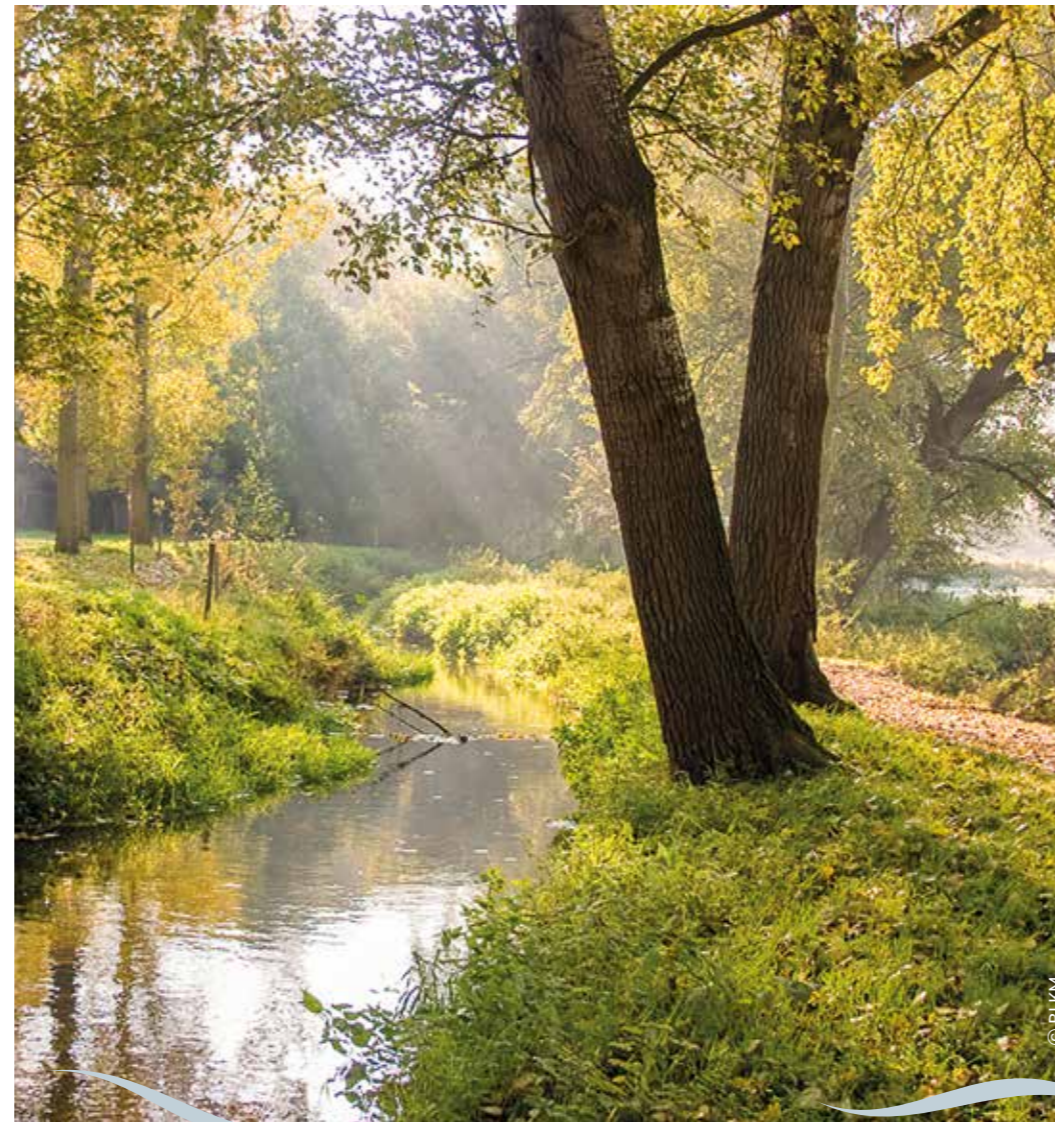

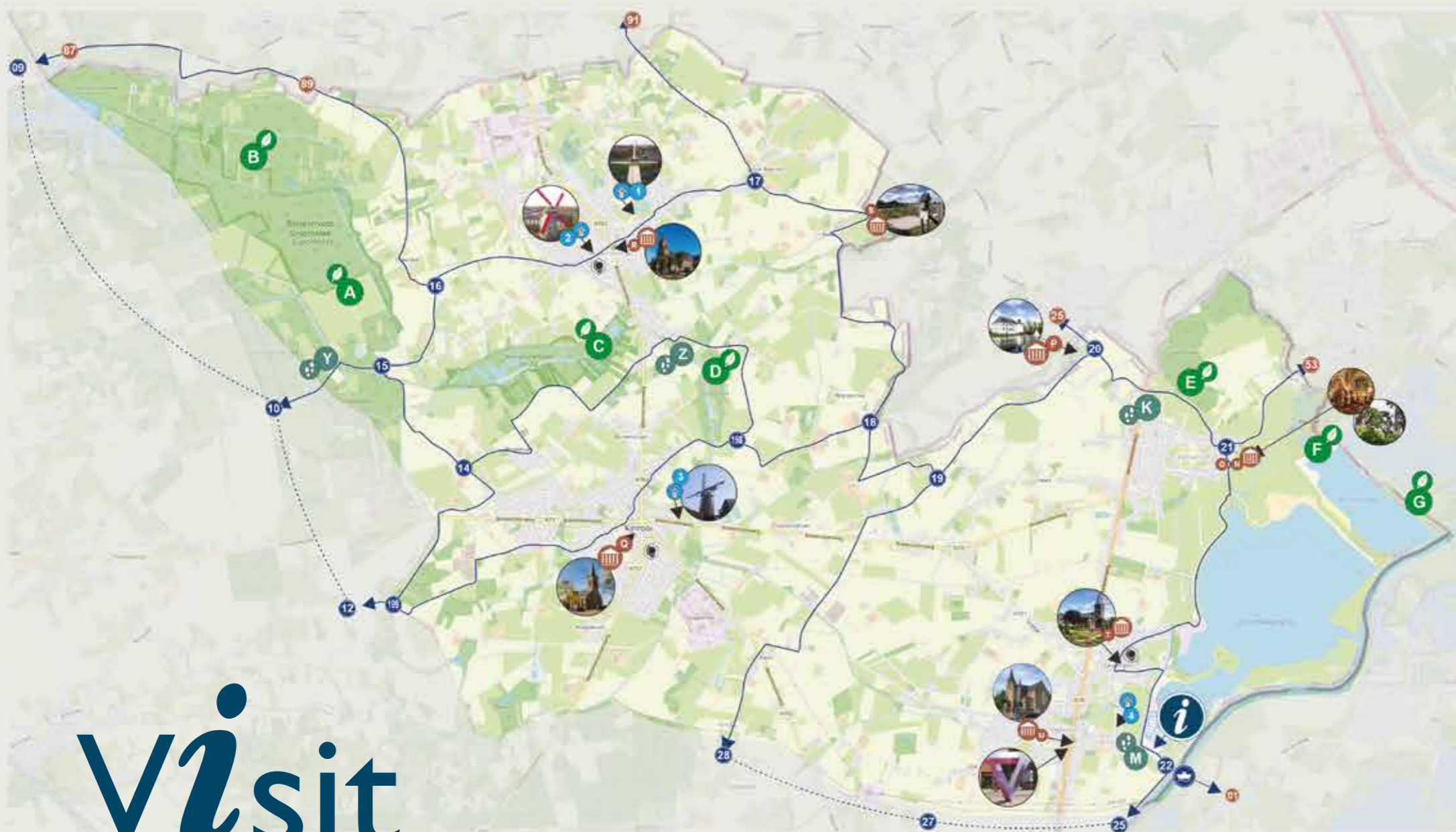

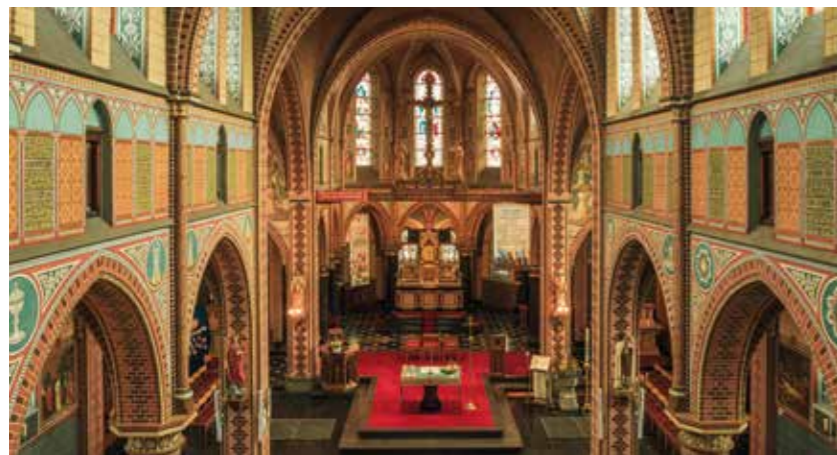

Borgitter Castle

"In among the golden green oak wood ..." lies Borgitter Castle. Unfortunately very little of the former castle is left standing, just like the oak trees that are referred to. The present classical building in the Maasland style dates from the end of the 18th century. A few years later, the Dutchman Gerard Krekeldberg wrote the text for the Limburg folk song here in Kessenich. The best of both Limburg provinces comes together in Kinrooi.

Cycling through the nature reserve

Since last year, Koningssteen-Kollegreend is accessible to cyclists. From junction 21, you can cycle straight through the nature reserve to end up in the white town of Thorn. Enjoy the wonderful views. Could you be careful with the grazing animals? They certainly need their rest.



The Bastion, so much more than events grounds

Near junction 21 lies the Bastion, one of the newest additions to the municipality of Kinrooi. These events grounds were artificially created by bringing in sand from the Maasplassen. The Bastion is not only the home base for the famous Bastion Festival, but also accommodates all kinds of parties, from weddings and private parties right through to magnificent pop-up bar in the summer. But above all, it offers a beautiful view over the Kinrooi Maasplassen.



Enchanting Kessenich

Known as 'Gem of the Maasland', or 'Thorn's little sibling', ... Kessenich continues to surprise. Nice and compact with a hint of history around every corner of its little alleys. Just a stone's throw away from big sister Thorn and at the

A forest paradise for young and old alike

Woutershof is not only a Hopper group residence where many young people enjoy a relaxing holiday every year. Situated on the border of Kempen~Broek, Woutershof is also Kinrooi's gateway to this versatile nature reserve. Strap on your walking boots and get to know Kempen~Broek. A boundless hiking experience, we can assure you!

While the children are having fun in the woods, dabbling in the play stream or playing tag in the meadow, parents and grandparents can enjoy a delicious picnic.

Practical

Woutershof is located at the Grootbroekstraat in Kinrooi. There is plenty of parking on site. Do bring your walking shoes, though, as you will need them.



... to De Goort

On a discovery tour with Tijn

De Goort is not only located in the centre of Kinrooi, it is also the home of Tijn, the Purple Emperor butterfly. Years of nature management have ensured that many animals have found their way to De Goort. Today, you are going to set off with Tijn, the Purple Emperor. This butterfly is Kinrooi's adopted species and is known to make the odd appearance in the area. During this walk, children from 3 to 6 can find out about the habitat of this butterfly in a playful way. So put on your walking shoes. Drag mum, dad, grandma and grandpa out of their chairs and get going!

Practical

This walk is approximately 2.5 km long and is free of charge. You can leave your car on the car park in Doorslagstraat without any problems. The walk with Tijn is signposted along the green walking route.



... to the Vijverbreek

Boundless enjoyment in nature

The Vijverbreek is a marshland area straddling Belgium and the Netherlands. Where the Meuse used to flow luxuriantly, there are beautiful marshy woods. It is best to put on your wellies because the wet grasslands are likely to give you wet feet before you know it! The Vijverbreek guarantees an ultimate nature experience, ranging from alder thickets to willow thickets and the most beautiful plants. But look around you every now and then, you might even spot one of the free-roaming cattle wanting to accompany you on your journey.

Asparagus municipality of Flanders

Is there no disputing about taste? Maybe not. But once you have tasted an asparagus from the soil of Kinrooi, you will know that our asparagus are the most delicious ones in the world. And that's not all: come and visit us again during the asparagus season. You are always welcome at the annual asparagus festivals to join the asparagus cycle tour or to visit one of our local farmers. Maybe you can even harvest your asparagus yourself?



Mottetoren (Motte Tower)

The Mottetoren was built in the 12th century in the centre of Kessenich. It was built on an artificial hill and served as a defence tower for the seigniori. After three excavations, the foundations of the tower and the later added constructions were uncovered and preserved. At the end of the 19th century, Baron Michiels van Kessenich had a burial chapel built for his family on the same hill. The 'hill' is freely accessible to the public. In 2021 and 2022 the site will be completely restored. In the autumn of 2022 the redevelopment of the village of Kessenich will be completely finished. So keep an eye on our social media. The 'mountain' is open to the public.

Kessenich

St Martin's Church

At the foot of the same hill is St Martin's Church. The back of the church tower contains remnants of a 12th-century Romanesque church. The tower in marlstone dates from the 16th century. The present church was built at the end of the 19th century against to the existing tower. The beautiful neo-Gothic interior rightfully earned this church the title of **'Gem of the Maasland'**. In the churchyard next to the church is the gravestone of Guido van Malsen (†1618), Lord of Kessenich, and Joanna van Kessenich (†1636). Next to it is the burial cross of Hobricht van Lind (†1678) and his family members.



Kessenich

Borgitter Castle

"In among the golden green oak wood ...", lies Borgitter Castle; In the 16th and 17th centuries, the Lords of Kessenich moved their centre of power to Borgitter. Jan van Waes built the Borgitter moated castle in the early 16th century. However, little remains of this castle today. The present classical building in Maasland style dates from the late 18th century. Behind the castle are the Breukskenshof and Halfeshof (farms), the estate manager's house and a 17th-century water mill.

The Limburg folk song was also written there, **"t nachtegaalje zingt..." (the nightingale is singing ...)**. In the early 20th century, the Dutch writer Gerard Krekelberg wrote the text here, which was later set to music. Nowhere else will you feel the Limburg feeling vibe than at Borgitter Castle.

Please note: the entire grounds are privately owned.



Molenbeersel

Reconstruction of electric wire

In the middle of the border between Belgium and the Netherlands, a part of the triple electric wire from WWI was reconstructed. A location where many lost their lives during the war is now a place of peace and introspection. A covered picnic area was built for visitors. Unfortunately this was destroyed last year and will be rebuilt in the course of 2022. A number of information boards will provide the necessary explanation about this monument.

2021 was the 10th anniversary of Kinrooi as 'Asparagus municipality of Flanders'. Not only are the most asparagus grown in Kinrooi, they are also the tastiest ones in Flanders. Kinrooi naturally



Kinrooi is a tiny municipality in the north of the province of Limburg. That in itself is not so unique, but with both the RivierPark Maasvallei and the GrensPark Kempen~Broek, the municipality does have access to Limburg's most beautiful cross-border nature reserves. Ideal for bike rides, brisk walks or simply some fresh air in nature. You want to come?

GrensPark Kempen~Broek

Straddling Belgian and Dutch Limburg and a small strip of North Brabant is the GrensPark Kempen~Broek, a 25,000 ha area that mixes up wet and dry, open and closed, as well as nature and culture. The Kinrooi part of this cross-border landscape is mainly found in Molenbeersel. There you

find the nature reserves of Stramprooierbroek, Grootbroek, Urlobroek, Zig and Goort.

Discover nature on foot, by bike or on horseback. The bicycle is the perfect way to explore this vast area even better. You can rent bikes from Visit Kinrooi. Contact us for

more information. Below we would like to give you some tips for the Kempen~Broek.

FOR THE KIDS Tijn, the Purple Emperor

Nature reserve De Goort is home to Tijn, the Purple Emperor. This butterfly is the adopted species of the municipality and pops up in the area from time to time. During the walk of about 2.5 km, children from 3 to 6 years of age can learn about De Goort and the rest of Tijn's habitat in a playful manner.

This walk is free of charge. Parking is available in the Doorslagstraat.



Kisserweide, an experience in and around nature

Kisserweide, which can be described as a special place, is located next to the nature reserve De Zig in Molenbeersel and is the home of lovely Sofie. People, nature and animals come together at Kisserweide. There is a play area for young and old, you can chill out in the 'chill' corner, go for a donkey ride or even learn to ride a horse during one of the pony-riding lessons. That's right: people and animals go hand in hand while you enjoy the peace and quiet and the many regional produce that Sofie can tell you all about.

On the move with the Guides

Discovering silence, turning into a real tracker, getting a taste of the wilderness or catching your breath in the vast nature of the GrensPark. You can now experience it even more intensely in the company of a guide. Every fourth Sunday of the month, you can set off on a guided hike. This is someone who knows the area like the back of his hand and will be happy to tell you all about the ins and outs of this magnificent nature. For the municipality of Kinrooi, the Woutershof in Molenbeersel is the gateway. On www.kempenbroek.eu you'll find a calendar with all the Guided activities. Are you staying in Kinrooi? Be sure to ask your accommodation manager about any extra activities. Go as a group, with family or friends, or go it alone. It is all possible. Admission is 2 euros per person and 5 euros per family.

The Kempen~Broek hiking maps

Kempen~Broek will surprise you with its special and varied landscape. The forests, marshes, stream valleys and hay meadows are home to many rare plant and animal species. By the way, did you know that Kempen~Broek boasts more dragonfly species than almost anywhere else

in the Benelux? Signposted routes allow you to get to know Kempen~Broek in all its facets.

That's why you should definitely drop by Visit Kinrooi. We'll be happy to tell you where it's best to leave your car and map out a nice route for you. If you prefer

RivierPark Maasvallei

The RivierPark Maasvallei is an exceptional nature park with the quirky Meuse river as the blue vein running through the area. The Meuse is an impressive rain river and forms the natural border between Belgium and the Netherlands for 40 km. Over the centuries, this stream has sculpted a varied and fascinating landscape.

This has resulted in a tangle of old river arms, river banks, gullies, cut-off meanders, dykes and floodplains. Adjacent to these, a few picturesque Meuse villages punctuate the landscape. High and low tides have brought great diversity. A diversity that is still being improved on today with the sole purpose of introducing as many new species into the RivierPark Maasvallei as possible.

Rose Trail

From mid-June to mid-September, Geistingen is ablaze with the most beautiful colours of roses, with no fewer than 2,000 roses adorning Mariapark that time of year. A total of 6,000 roses can be admired in this beautiful Meuse village. Come and experience this period with us. The rose route is 6 km long and takes you, among others, along the ornamental garden and rose garden of the Pepels family and Luc Van Esser's ADR Rosarium Geistinger Landhoff. During this period, both gardens can be visited on Wednesdays by individual visitors free of charge.

The price of the hiking map is €4.00. You will be offered a 'dröpke' (a 'drop' of alcohol) and an ice cream along the way.

FOR THE KIDS

'Rijntje and his friends'

In the Vijverbroek nature reserve, a 2.3 km activity trail has been set up for the youngest nature lovers. The 'Rijntje and his friends' walk is a mix between beautiful drawings, based on the natural inhabitants of the area, and fun hands-on tasks to get to know nature in the RivierPark Maasvallei.

The hiking route is suitable for toddlers from 2.5 and upwards. Especially to stimulate the feeling of being close to nature, the route has not been made extra accessible for buggies.

A delicious local story

A little test: take a look around you when you drive into Kinrooi? That's right! Whether by car, bicycle, or any other means of transport. You cannot get around it. Kinrooi is an agricultural municipality. That is nothing new in Flanders, is it? No, that is true. But did you know that Kinrooi is the largest vegetable garden in Flanders?

Indeed it is. More than 30 different varieties of vegetables and fruit are grown in Kinrooi. Quite a lot, isn't it? From leeks over raspberries and strawberries to the still unknown descendant 'the yacón'. At the head of this family is our queen: the asparagus. Unique, pure and delicious. We would like to tell you more about it.

The white gold

The asparagus' nickname is the white gold. Where does the name come from? Well, we all know that buying gold is not that cheap. And to be honest: compared to fellow vegetables, the asparagus isn't either.

The start of the asparagus season varies from year to year. But on average, the start is around the second half of April and the beginning of May. The end of the season is fixed: 24 June, or the celebration of Sint-Jan.

During this period, many kilos of asparagus are harvested in Kinrooi. Harvesting the asparagus is quite labour-intensive. The temporary nature and the necessary labour give the asparagus this nickname.

Asparagus farmer talking

Hello, my name is Johan Driessens. Together with my wife and children I have been an asparagus farmer in Kinrooi for many years. The asparagus season is traditionally the best time of the year for us. All year round, we work with our whole family and employees to deliver the best quality of asparagus. During the season, there is a wonderful atmosphere throughout the community. Everyone knows they are here again, people come from far and wide to buy them on the farm, and we all see each other again at the asparagus festival. That gives me such satisfaction!



Pure craftsmanship

Growing asparagus is pure craftsmanship. That is the least you can say about this special process. The growth of an asparagus actually starts in spring. Then the beds are raised and the asparagus plants can start growing. A farmer can harvest asparagus from this plant for about 10 years.

The asparagus of Kinrooi are mostly white. This is because they are not exposed to light. But you can also find them in a green or purple colour.

When we say that it is always a bit warmer in Limburg, the people of Kinrooi take that very literally. During spring the asparagus plant gets the chance to grow. The traditional period to harvest the asparagus is from April to 24 June. On that day we celebrate Sint-Jan.

Just like we make it rain when we want to, we can also largely control the temperature of the beds. When growing white asparagus, the beds are usually covered with black and white foil. This is used to prevent discolouration, but also to speed up or slow down any harvesting. The black colour attracts the sun, which speeds up the process. The white colour repels the heat. We won't elaborate on that now. We invite you to discover them yourself at one of our farmers.

Then, the joyful moment! At some point the head of the asparagus will be visible. High time to harvest it. This is almost always done by hand. After harvesting, the asparagus are taken away to be cleaned, cut to size and judged for quality. Don't want to peel them yourself? Then you can simply ask for peeled asparagus.

What a process. Do you now understand why growing asparagus is one of the purest forms of craftsmanship? So we are rightly proud that in Kinrooi we have more than 50 hectares of asparagus fields. It is a tough job to grow them all. We do this with enthusiasm, passion and a clear goal in mind: to offer you the tastiest product. Curious for more? You are more than welcome at Visit Kinrooi. 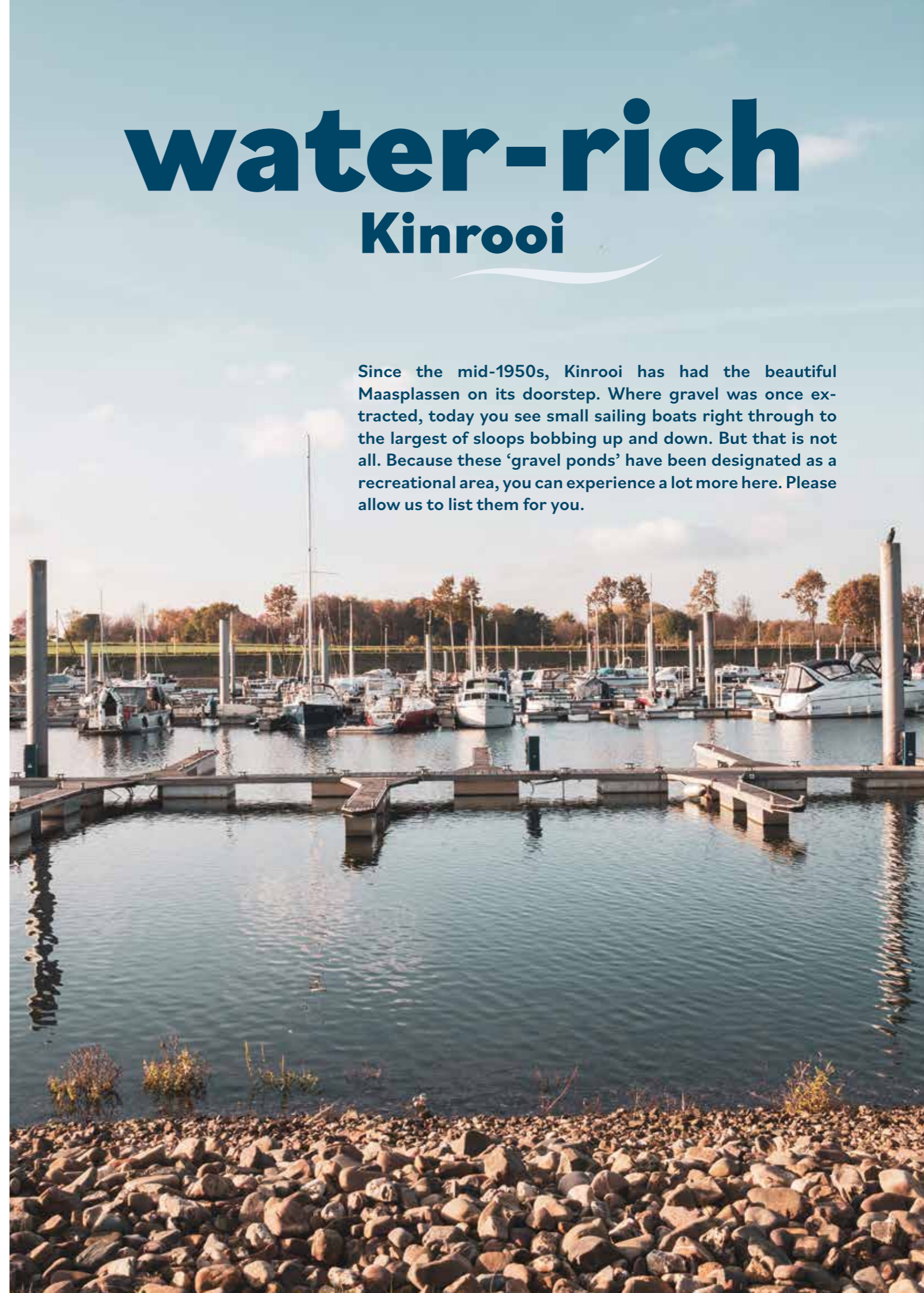

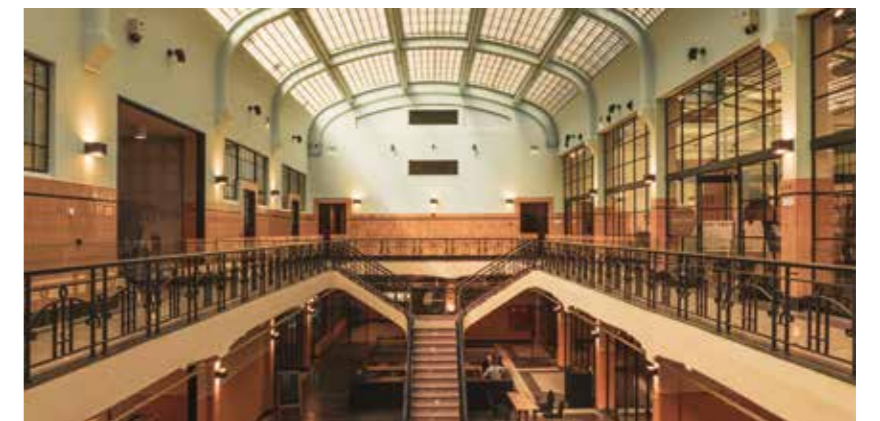
